





Officers were asked to assist the Roscommon County Sheriff Department in a vehicle pursuit on M-18. The suspect vehicle was heading North bound on M-18 towards the Village of Roscommon at high rates of speed. Officers were asked to deploy road spikes if possible. Officers were able to get to a safe location on M-18 just South of Robinson Lake Rd. prior to the suspect vehicle passing through. Officers were able to deploy the road spikes and were successful. The suspect vehicle ran over two spikes causing the left front tire of the vehicle to deflate. Officers then joined as the second unit in the pursuit which ended on Cherven Lane due to the driver losing control of the vehicle and rolling it. The driver was apprehended and the passenger was taken to the hospital for further evaluation.


