SPRING CLEAN UP & ORDINANCE ENFORCEMENT

Keep in mind as you start your spring yard clean ups that Gerrish Township has rules and regulations on Trash and Leave Burning, Junk & Garbage, Abandoned/Inoperable Vehicles and Garage/Yard Sales (which also require a permit). These Ordinances, and all other Gerrish Township Ordinances can be found at the Gerrish Township website at www.gerrishtownship.org under the Services/Departments Tab. You can also pick up a hard copy of any Ordinance at the Gerrish Township Municipal Center or the Gerrish Twp. Police Department. Yard waste pick up begins on April 10th and runs every other week until November 20th. Gerrish Township also offers a compost site that is located behind the Gerrish Township Police Department for leaves, small branches and other natural yard waste. ACT-NOW also has a Scrap Metal Project that runs from mid-April through October. You can place your scrap metal in the ACT-NOW utility trailer that is kept on the South side of the Impound Lot behind the Police Department. This project supports community programs

sponsored by ACT-NOW throughout the year.

Gerrish Twp. Police Department along with CERT Coordinator Sharon Zacny ran a 6-week Basic CERT class during February and March. This course consists of 20 hours of classroom and practical training in disciplines such as first aid, triage, search and rescue, utility shut off, fire safety, disaster preparedness, use of personal protective equipment, communications and the Incident Command System. Once certified these volunteers are crucial in giving immediate support to our local, state and federal emergency services. They also provide valuable traffic safety and crowd control in our local area during large scale community activities and events.
