GRAYSON'S GIFT PROJECT is one the programs supported by ACT NOW. The purpose of this project is to provide smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors for the hard of hearing and deaf children and senior citizens in Roscommon County. There are 85 children and over 250 seniors that would benefit from this 3-Phase which project has a target completion date of December 2019. Deaf or hard of hearing residents

Deaf or hard of hearing residents cannot hear the high-pitched tones of most smoke/fire alarms or CO detectors and therefore require special strobe and bed shaker alarms which are quite costly and are not covered by insurance.

Grayson is the one-year old son of Chris and Kristen Carmany who was born partially deaf. Chris is a firefighter with Gerrish Twp. Fire Department and Kristen is an advocate for the Deaf/Hard of Hearing community and a Michigan Hands & Voices Board Member.

ASSESSMENT CHILDREN'S CENTER is another program sponsored annually by ACT NOW. This is a new service in Roscommon available to Roscommon, Crawford, Ogemaw and Oscoda Counties. The center provides child forensic interviewing, counseling, victim advocate support and assessment services. Trained professionals work with Law Enforcement and Child Protective Services in caring, supporting and assisting young victims of crime. The center's Mission is "To prevent and educate the public on child abuse and neglect, as well as to reduce the trauma of child abuse and neglect by providing a timely, comprehensive and multidisciplinary response to allegations in a safe, agency neutral,

child focused setting."

## Winter Weather Preparedness

PART III ~ Caught in a Winter Storm STAY INSIDE!

When using alternate heat from a fireplace, wood stove, space heater, etc., use fire safeguards and properly ventilate.

If NO HEAT...

- Close off unneeded rooms.
- Stuff towels or rags in cracks under doors to avoid heat escaping.
- Cover windows at night.
- Eat...food provides the body with energy for producing its own heat.
- Drink...keep the body replenished with fluids to prevent dehydration.

### OUTSIDE

Wear layers of loose-fitting,
light-weight, warm clothing and remove
layers as needed to avoid overheating,
perspiration and subsequent chill.
Trapped air insulates. Outer garments
should be water repellent. Wear a hat
or hood, half your body heat loss can
be from the head. Cover your mouth

hands to avoid hypothermia.

Avoid overexertion such as heavy snow shoveling, pushing a car or walking in deep snow which can lead to heart attacks.
