October & November...

Are dangerous months for deer/vehicle crashes with over 1,200 injuries per year. Here are some safety tips to help avoid dangerous encounters with deer (or other wildlife):

- Stay awake, alert and sober
- · Always wear a safety belt
- · Be especially alert at dawn and dusk
- Reduce your speed when traveling through deer populated areas
- If you see one deer, slow down as others are likely nearby
- · If a crash is unavoidable, DO NOT SWERVE
- Brake firmly, hold on to steering wheel with both hands, stay in your lane, bring your vehicle to a controlled stop and steer your vehicle well off the roadway.
- Call 911 to report incident or if you need medical assistance
- YOU MUST REPORT ALL TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS (even with deer or wildlife) IF:
- · There are injuries involved
- · Damage to your vehicle is over \$1,0000
- There is damage to someone else's property (i.e. mailbox, fence, etc. not matter the amount of damage)
