

Tax Scam Season



On February 27, 2025, the IRS announced its annual "Dirty Dozen" list of tax scams for 2025. "Scammers are relentless, and they use the guise of tax season to try tricking taxpayers into falling into a variety of traps. These red flags can lead to everything from identity theft to being misled into claiming tax credits for which they're not entitled."

The IRS continues to see a barrage of email and text scams to lure unsuspecting victims into providing valuable personal and financial information such as Phishing (phony emails) and Smishing (fake text messages) that may state your account has been put on hold or you have unusual activity reported on your account. Do not open these!

Other areas to be aware of can be bad social media advice with misleading tax information, scammers stating they are from a "third-party" or fake charity, misleading offers to prepare taxes from "ghost" preparers, and a wide array of other bogus schemes.

The IRS's first contact with you will always be a letter in the mail, not a phone call, email, or text message.

Never give out your personal information on the phone, email or text if you are not sure who you are communicating with.

You only need to get a police report on scams and fraud if you have experienced a financial loss.
